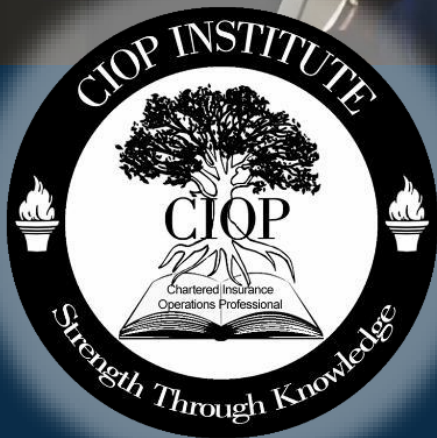

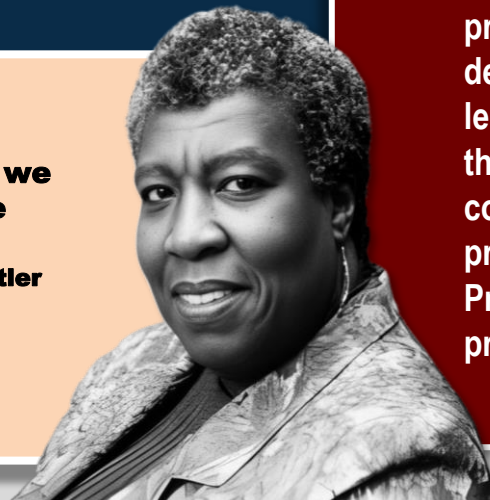


A holistic approach to helping people achieve continuous professional growth and enduring wellbeing
